

Suggested Donations

No reservation will be final without a non-refundable, non-transferable booking fee of \$100 (week) or \$50 (weekend, day) at the time of the reservation.

Requests for changes need to be accompanied by an extra \$100/\$50 booking fee.

Overnight donations for a limit of 11 people:

7-8 day week: Friday 4pm to Friday 1pm, \$800

3-4 day stay: Thursday 4pm to Sunday 1pm, \$400

2-3 day weekend: Friday 4pm to Sunday 1pm, \$300

Each person over the 11 limit will be expected to pay \$25 per night.

Day Groups up to 25 people: \$200.

Full donation is expected upon receiving the key for the Retreat House. One also needs to sign a form of intent to abide by the established rules. Any violation will be evaluated before further registration becomes possible.

The Retreat House is equipped with all the comforts of home including:

- The second floor has 10 single bedrooms, each with a sink, plus two bathrooms with bath and shower. It also has a sun deck.
- The first floor has a kitchen, pantry and laundry room, bedroom, bathroom with bath and shower, dining room and living room combination with enough tables and chairs for a family reunion, and a conference room.
- Sheets, pillow cases, & blankets.
- Dishes, glasses, silverware, pots and pans and coffee makers.
- Cleaning supplies, laundry detergent and dish detergent.
- A microwave, stove, refrigerator and a dishwasher.
- A gas Barbecue Grill (you provide the propane) and plenty of beach chairs and outdoor furniture.
- The grounds have decks overlooking the lake.
- A swimming and fishing area. (fishing licenses required)



Things you should know before coming to the Retreat House 😊

- All you need to bring are your clothes, toiletries, food and drinking water.
- Towels are available but we encourage you to bring your own.
- Please respect the neighbors' boundaries. The property line is the row of shrubs on the right hand side if you are facing the lake.
- Help yourself to food left behind. Please do not leave perishables unless you know someone else will use them.
- There is no smoking or animals allowed on the premises.
- There is no trash pick up at the Retreat House. You will need to empty all the trash receptacles and take the trash with you when you leave.
- We ask that you please leave the house in the same condition you found it. (A vacuum and other cleaning items can be found in the room under the stairs, or under the sinks in the bathroom).
- A detailed list of house rules can be found in the house and in all the upstairs' bedrooms .
- Please do not move furniture from one house level to another.
- Heat must be turned off and all doors locked and secured before leaving.
